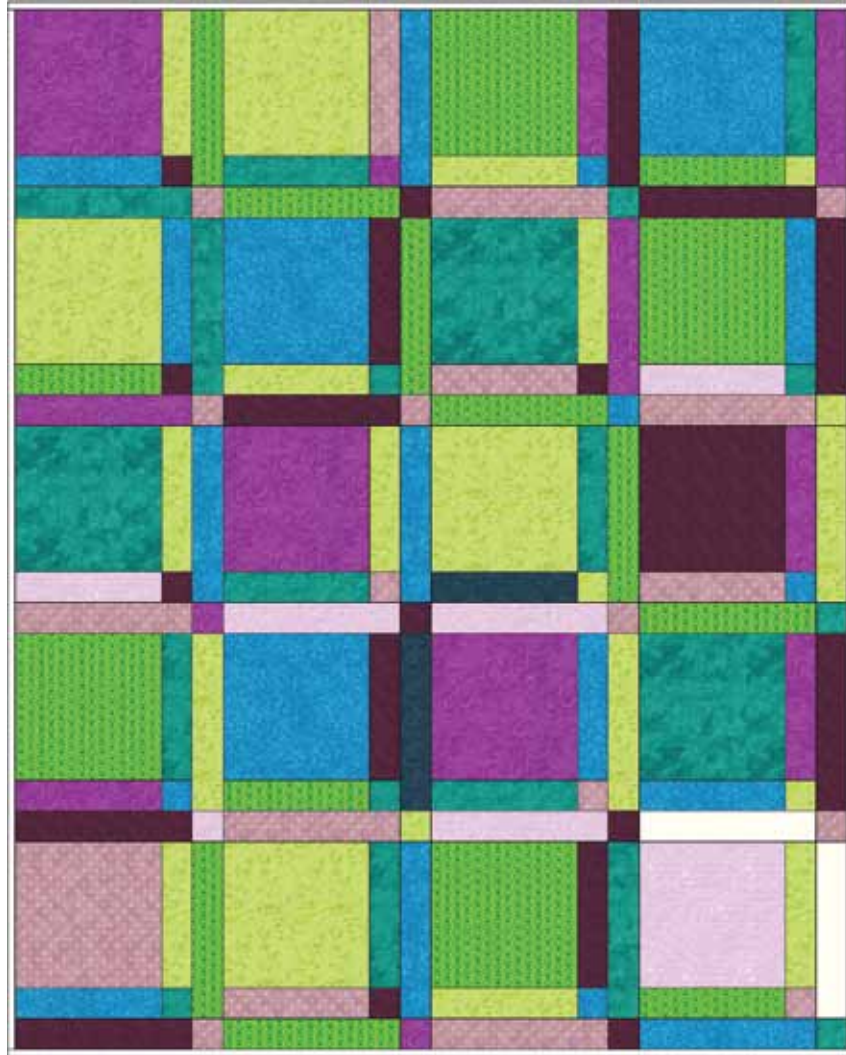

## “Welcome to our Studio” Quilt Pattern

Just a layer cake and a jelly roll makes up to 40 “Studio Blocks”

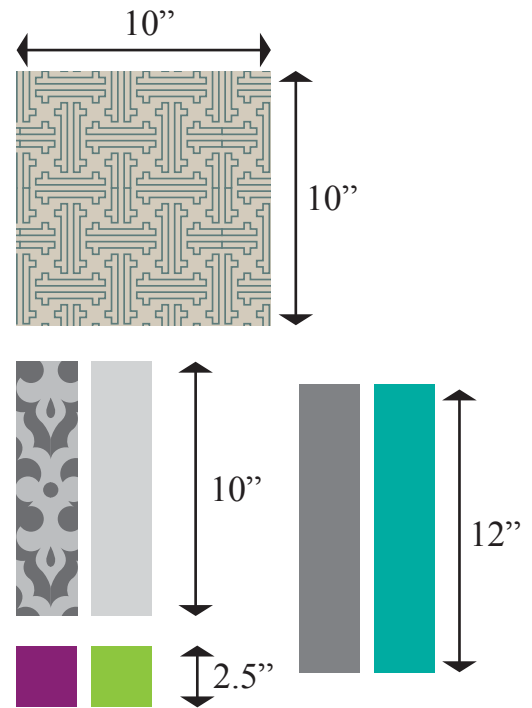

Each block will consist of:

- 1 10" block  
(from the layer cake)
- 2 10" long strips  
(from the jelly roll)
- 2 12" long strips  
(from the jelly roll)
- 2 2.5" squares\*  
(from the jelly roll)

Randomly choose layers and strips to vary the pattern. \*The 2.5" squares can be random or from the same fabric to create a focus/regular pattern.



Add 10 in. jelly roll strip to the bottom of a 10 in. block.

Sew a 2 1/2 in. square to another 10 in. strip. Sew this to the right side of the previous block/strip.

Now to the bottom add a 12 in. strip.

Sew a 2 1/2 square to a 12 inch strip. and add that to the right side. You should now have a 14 inch unfinished block.

Continue randomly making blocks.

Sew together to make whatever size quilt you prefer (4x5, 5x6, 6x6, etc.) You can also use leftover blocks to make bedrunners, table runners, placemats.
